<u>Important Note</u>: The cookies that we classify as our own are essential to be able to browse our site normally. However, you have the option to disable and delete cookies in the browser. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on the device from which you connect to our website. They allow the website to remember information about your visit, such as the language, which will be recovered later to improve and facilitate navigation.

Cookies usually store technical information, personal preferences, content customization, usage statistics, links to social networks, access to user accounts, etc.

They are only associated with your browser (anonymous user) and do not provide personal data by themselves. Cookies cannot harm your device and are also very useful, as they help us identify and resolve errors.

What do we use cookies for?

On this website we use cookies to:

- → Ensure that the website can function correctly.
- → Collect anonymous statistical information, such as what pages you have viewed or how long you have been on the website.

What types of cookies do we use on this website?

STT Group requires implementing its own technical cookies to offer its web services and additionally provide quality service to all users who use our services.

This website and its subsites may collect anonymous logs during user visits. This is done through cookies or similar technologies to retain information about you and your use of our website.

Below we inform the functionalities of each type of cookies:

	Type of cookies	Usage
1	Technical cookies	They allow the user to navigate through the website or platform and use the different options or services that exist there, such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing access parts. restricted, use security elements while browsing or store content for the dissemination of videos or sound or share content through social networks. These are session and persistent cookies.
2	Personalization cookies	They allow the user to access the service with some predefined characteristics based on a series of criteria on the user's terminal, such as, for example, the type of browser through which the service is accessed, the regional configuration from which the service is accessed, etc. Third parties such as Google, YouTube or Twitter use this type of persistent personalization cookies regarding their services.
3	Analytical cookies	They are those that allow the number of users to be quantified and thus carry out the measurement and statistical analysis of the use that users make of a website in order to improve it.

How to manage cookies in the browser?

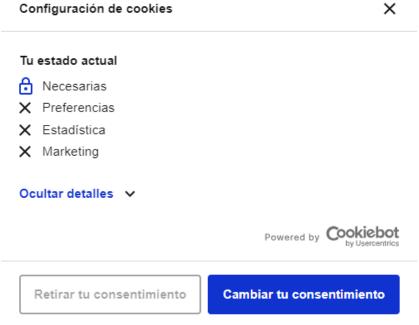
